Understanding the Betting Options

- **Coin Flip:** An easy 50/50 style mini-game featuring a red and blue coin with multipliers.

- The left reel picks a bet area (a number or a reward video game).
- The ideal reel selects a random multiplier (varying from 2x as much as 50x).

If the Top Slot successfully matches the winning segment on the primary wheel, the multiplier is applied either to the winning number payment or to the multipliers inside the subsequent perk video game.  - High volatility; relies totally on hitting reward rounds regularly enough to balance out the constant losses on non-bonus spins.
- **The Balanced Spread:**
