GFCI outlet installation, which provides ground-fault protection and is often required in kitchens and bathrooms, costs between \$130 and \$300 per outlet because of the specialized outlet type and testing involved. Level 2 EV charger installation ranges from \$500 to \$2,000 depending on wiring distance and electrical panel capacity. Whole-house rewiring, which older homes like those in Mesta Park sometimes require, runs \$8,000 to \$20,000 because of the labor intensity and material volume. A whole-house generator installation costs \$5,000 to \$15,000.
