- Numbers: 1, 2, 5, and 10
- Perk Rounds: Cash Hunt, Pachinko, Coin Flip, and Crazy Time

Before every main wheel spin, a leading slot above the wheel spins concurrently. This top slot designates a random multiplier to one of the bet sections (either a number or a perk video game). If that segment strikes on the main wheel and is matched with the multiplier, all earnings for that sector are increased accordingly.

Breakdown of the Wheel Segments

The Four Exciting Bonus Rounds

The true appeal of Crazy Time lies in its 4 distinct bonus offer rounds. When the wheel arrive at a perk segment, taking part gamers are transferred from the primary studio into an interactive, augmented-reality minigame.



1. Coin Flip

- **Frequency:** 4 sections on the wheel.
- **How it works:** A coin with a red side and a blue side is flipped by a device. Each side is assigned a random multiplier before the flip. Whichever color lands face up figures out the player's payment.
- **Re-flip feature:** If the multipliers designated to the coin are exceptionally low, the host might set off a "Rescue" re-flip to give gamers a chance at much better worths.

2. Pachinko

- **Frequency:** 2 segments on the wheel.
- **How it works:** Inspired by the traditional Japanese arcade game, players are revealed a large wall filled with physical pegs. The host drops a puck from the top, and it bounces down the board up until it lands in one of numerous multiplier zones at the bottom.
- **Double function:** If the puck lands in a "Double" slot, all multipliers on the board double, and the host drops the puck once again for even bigger rewards.

3. Cash Hunt

- **Frequency:** 2 sections on the wheel.
- **How it works:** This is a shooting gallery-style perk round. A huge screen displays 108 random multipliers hidden behind various carnival symbols (such as a cactus, a target, or a chef's hat). Gamers use an on-screen crosshair to aim and shoot at one symbol before a countdown timer ends. When the timer ends, all signs expose their hidden multipliers.

4. Crazy Time

- **Frequency:** 1 sector on the wheel.
- **How it works:** The ultimate perk round. The host opens a red door leading into a lively, surreal virtual world including a huge 64-segment wheel. Players need to choose one of 3 flappers (Green, Blue, or Yellow). The wheel is spun, and whatever multiplier the picked flapper indicate is awarded. Like Pachinko, this wheel includes "Double" and "Triple" sectors, which can press multipliers up to a shocking 20,000 x.

Popular Strategies for Playing Crazy Time

Because Crazy Time is a game of possibility governed by RNG and physical possibility, no method can guarantee a revenue. However, players usually embrace different techniques based upon their threat tolerance and bankroll management styles.

- **The Safe/Conservative Strategy:**

- *Focus:* Betting primarily on numbers 1 and 2, with periodic little cover bets on reward rounds.
- *Objective:* To prolong gameplay and minimize rapid bankroll depletion, relying on regular little wins.

- **The Bonus Hunter Strategy:**

- *Focus:* Placing bets exclusively on the four benefit rounds (Coin Flip, Pachinko, Cash Hunt, and Crazy Time).
- *Objective:* To avoid the lower-paying base game numbers completely and chase after the massive multipliers discovered just in the perk functions. This requires a bigger bankroll to endure dry spells between bonus offer hits.

- **The Balanced Approach:**

- *Focus:* Spreading bets throughout both numbers and benefit segments.
- *Goal:* Keeping the balance ticking over with numbers while keeping a ticket to every significant benefit round that hits the wheel.
