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What Does the Lockout Workflow Add to Your Emergency Bill?

Once power is de-energized, a licensed electrician must execute a lockout workflow—a formal series of steps that prevents accidental re-energization while repair work happens. This is not just turning off a breaker; it involves tagging the breaker, verifying de-energization with a test meter, and sometimes physically securing the panel to prevent someone else from flipping it back on.
