3. The Smoke Grenade Frame Drop & Crash The Symptom

- **The Cause:** Because CS2 smokes are volumetric objects that connect with lighting and bullets, they require significant GPU calculate power and VRAM. Overloaded GPUs may timeout and crash the game.
- **The Fix:** Lower your international shadow quality, particle detail, and shader detail in the video settings. Ensure your graphics card's VRAM isn't being entirely taken in by background applications.

4. Third-Party Overlay Collisions

- **The Symptom:** Crashing arbitrarily mid-round, often accompanied by a generic "Unhandled Exception" error.
- **The Cause:** Conflicts in between the Source 2 graphics API and overlay software such as Discord, NVIDIA GeForce Experience, RivaTuner Statistics Server (RTSS), or third-party skin trading platforms.
- **The Fix:** Disable overlays one by one to isolate the culprit. Disabling the Discord overlay and limiting background recording software frequently resolves this instantly.
