Communicating with the Honoree in Advance

The essential element for making this work is to obtain all the relevant info in advance without compromising the hidden nature of the event.



Talk to the guest of honor about what they generally like without being too obvious. Ask questions like: "What's your favorite color scheme for events?"

Create a detailed questionnaire for the guest of honor to complete as if it's for the general planning process that covers all the information you require without exposing the hidden nature.

Getting Remote Visuals

In the digital age, you don't have to get someone to a site physically for them to understand the space.

Take advantage of digital walkthroughs with the site manager to give the guest of honor a look at the location without them needing to be on-site.

Capture images and footage from different perspectives and show them to the guest of honor as part of the normal planning steps.



Your planner can guide this process and can even produce an online concept board that illustrates the design, mood, and energy of the celebration before it's fully planned.

Trust and Delegation

When you're unable to ask the guest of honor, it becomes especially important to trust your planner.

Experienced planners have done this many times before and know how to pick elements that the birthday person will adore.

They'll use their experience to determine the most suitable choices for the venue layout, the aesthetics, the food, and the performances.

Managing the Event Itself

When the big day arrives, your coordinator will be the one managing all the moving parts even though the guest of honor hasn't visited the site.

They'll have backup options in case the guest of honor has objections and they'll be prepared to adapt quickly.

When the honoree finally arrives, everything will be arranged and they'll be thrilled not just by the party itself but also by how well it suits them even though they didn't see it beforehand.
