I ascertain the suspension compresses a slightly, then recheck after the primary mile. On a scooter, I steer clear of

tying to the clutch cope with if it's plastic, and I choose wheel nets mixed with a body loop, then I isolate plastics with microfiber wraps where a strap would rub. It takes five further mins and saves you a paint correction later.
