Why Psychology Plays a Part

The "Mystery" in Mystery Mines describes the psychological stress. As soon as you clear three or 4 tiles, the brain starts to convince you that the next tile is "safe." In reality, every click is an independent occasion. The game does not "remember" that you opened three safe tiles in a row.



Best Practices for Mystery Mines

- **Set a Stop-Loss:** Before you begin, pick the optimum amount you want to lose. Once that limit is reached, leave.
- **Do Not Chase Losses:** If you hit a mine on your first tile, don't double your bet to try and "get it back." This is the fastest method to diminish a bankroll.
- **Balance the Grid:** Adjust the mine count based upon your risk tolerance. If you prefer a longer session, keep the mine count low. If you choose an adventure, keep the count high but lower your system stake.
