### Market Overview

The CS2 skin market operates on [CS2skin](#) Steam's neighborhood marketplace and third-party trading platforms. Rates are driven by:



- **Supply vs. Demand**-- Low supply combined with high demand (e.g., from professional gamers or influencers) inflates costs.
- **Condition**-- Factory-new (FN) products fetch a premium; very little wear (MW) and field-tested (FT) are less expensive but still preferable.
- **Economic Factors**-- Seasonal sales, brand-new case releases, and fluctuations in cryptocurrency worths can sway market trends.

Since the market is mainly player-driven, costs can be volatile. Staying notified about recent trades, case openings, and tournament occasions is important for any severe collector.
