What makes garages and sheds different

- T1-11 or difficult sawn plywood with deep grooves that gather airborne dirt and dust and chalk
- OSB panels with manufacturing unit resin that may repel early coats if no longer prepped well
- Galvanized metal and aluminum storage doors that make bigger and settlement with heat
- Vinyl or PVC trim, specifically on prefab sheds
- Cinder block, stucco, or brick on older indifferent garages

The consequence is a mixed-drapery undertaking where primers and topcoats need to substitute through surface. What bonds superbly to cedar may also fail on galvanized metallic. The means you caulk tough plywood seams differs from what you do at a metallic door stile. Another difference is illness. Garages and sheds stay closer to soil, sprinklers, fertilizer overspray, and the grime plume from mowers and blowers. Siding close grade traps moisture and dust. Finally, stream and warmth are extra serious. Uninsulated outbuildings swing from chilly mornings to blistering afternoons. A very good web site stroll saves hours and callbacks. I elevate a moisture meter, a scraper, and a roll of blue tape. The meter tells me what my eye can't. A swift scrape try exhibits whether we are managing a weak layer, recurrently outdated chalky latex over oil, that demands aggressive prep. Blue tape helps me mark all punch units so nothing is overlooked.

Look for those patterns:

- Chalking and UV burn on south and west faces. If your hand comes away white after a rub, you desire a rinse with a light detergent and, in some situations, an acrylic bonding primer.

- Rust bleed on metal fasteners and hinges. That needs a rust converter or a right away to metallic primer, now not simply extra paint.
- Oil and silicone round garage door tracks and weatherstripping. Solvent cleaning, then a rinse, prevents fish eyes.
- Hairline cracks wherein T1-eleven grooves meet horizontal trim. Water drives in there. A top elasticity sealant with a genuine backer bead keeps the joint from tearing.
- Efflorescence on block walls. That white bloom will push paint off unless the salts are scrubbed away and the wall can dry.

On T1-11, I favor a penetrating alkyd primer on weathered wood, then a full acrylic topcoat. For new OSB or plywood from a shed package, wait for mill glaze and prime resin. A scuff sand, a radical easy, and a great bonding primer cease early peeling.

On metallic garage doorways, the substrate might be manufacturing facility baked tooth or powder coat. Both are slick.
