1. The New Smoke Meta

Actionable Tips to Win More Matches

- **Interact Clearly:** Callouts need to be succinct. Instead of stating "*He's over there!*", state "*One gamer, low health, holding ramp with an AWP.*"
- **Master the Recoil Patterns:** Spend time in deathmatch servers learning spray patterns for the AK-47, M4A1-S, and Galil/Famas.
