* Note: "Surr" means Late Surrender (if available). "S/D" means Double if allowed, otherwise Stand.

Key Rules to Look for in Live Casinos

- **Blackjack Payouts:** Always look for tables that pay **3:2** for a natural blackjack. Avoid tables that pay **6:5**, as this considerably increases your house advantage.
- **Dealership Soft 17 Rule:** Check whether the dealer should strike or stand on a soft 17 (an Ace and a 6). A dealer standing on soft 17 is more beneficial to the gamer.

- **Double Down Restrictions:** Some tables limit doubling down to tough totals of 10 and 11 just, while others permit doubling on any two cards. The latter is always much better for the player.
