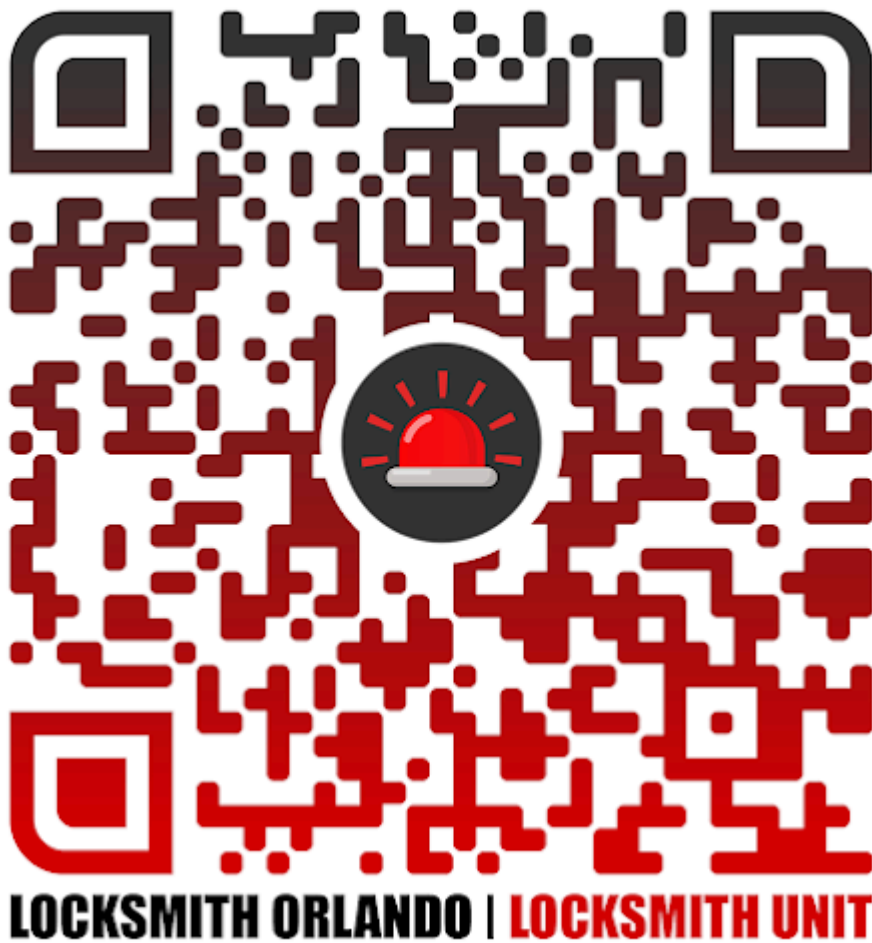
The same caution applies to break in repairs and higher value security work.
