- **Trade Lock Implementations:** To fight immediate skin trading on gambling sites, Valve presented a **7-day trade hold**. If a player gets a skin in a trade, they can not trade it once again for a full week. This badly interfered with the automated, high-frequency trading bots utilized by CSGO gambling establishments.
- **Account Bans:** Valve regularly bans accounts associated with business gambling, resulting in millions of dollars worth of skins being locked completely inside banned inventories.

Despite these steps, the market has actually shown remarkably durable, constantly progressing brand-new workarounds to bypass Valve's restrictions.
