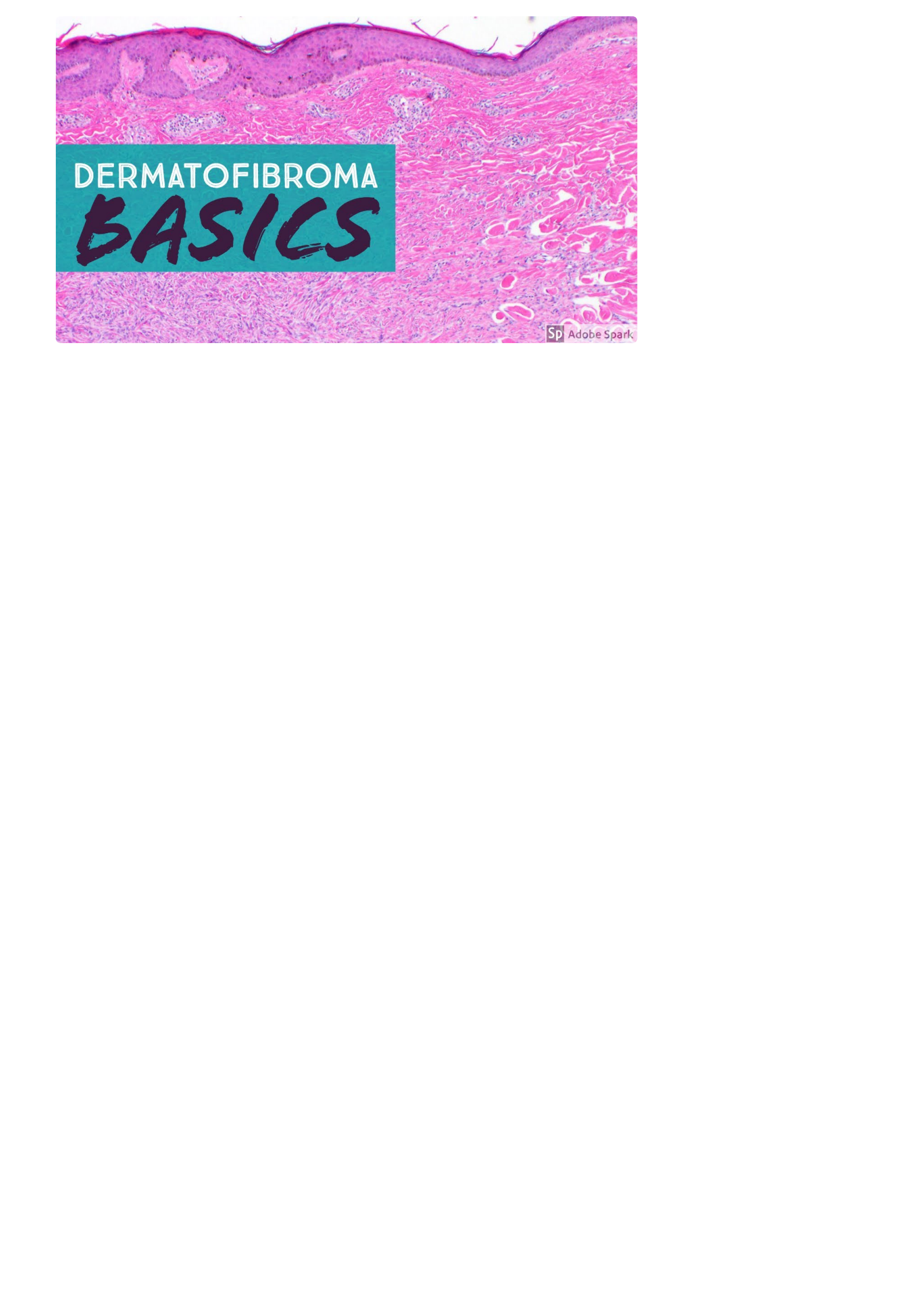
Will a cherry angioma disappear on its own?
