- **Roulette:** Players wager on colors (generally red, black, or green) with differing payment chances.

4. Update

A mechanic distinct to skin gambling sites.

- **How it works:** A player chooses a skin from their stock that they want to trade up, chooses a target skin of greater value, and spins a wheel. The wheel's success zone diminishes or grows depending upon the mathematical difference in between the two items' values.

- **API Restrictions:** Changes to Steam's Application Programming Interface (API) have made it harder for automated gambling bots to operate efficiently.
