

A broken garage door can impact entry, protection, and the safety of your home. Whether your garage door will not open, closes unevenly, or makes a loud grinding sound, prompt garage door repair can stop a minor issue from becoming a costly failure.

## **What Are the Most Frequent Garage Door Problems in Los Angeles?**

An overhead garage door contains several linked components, including panels, hinges, rollers, tracks, cables, springs, and an automatic opener. A problem in one area can impact the entire system. Common service requests include a damaged garage door panel, a broken garage door spring, worn rollers, bent tracks, loose hardware, and a garage door opener that fails to respond.

Some issues appear slowly. You might notice a door becoming less responsive, louder, or less balanced before it stops working. Others happen suddenly, such as a broken spring or cable. ## **Why Is My Garage Door Not Opening or Shutting?**

If your garage door will not open, start with basic door opener troubleshooting. Check whether the opener has power, confirm that the remote control has fresh batteries, and try the wall-mounted switch. If the wall switch works but the remote does not, the issue may involve the remote, its programming, or the opener receiver.



Photo-eye sensors are another frequent cause. These small sensors sit near the floor on both sides of the garage door. If they are dirty, misaligned, blocked, or damaged, the opener may not close the door or may reverse immediately. Gently clean the lenses and confirm that both sensor indicator lights are visible. Do not bypass the sensors, because they are an important safety feature.

Track alignment can also prevent easy movement. A bent track, loose bracket, or obstruction may cause the door to bind. If the motor runs but the door does not move, the drive gear, trolley, spring, or lifting cable may require expert evaluation. Avoid repeatedly pressing the opener, since continued operation can damage the motor or worsen a mechanical problem.

### **Why Is My Garage Door Loud, Misaligned, or Stuck?**

A noisy garage door may have poorly lubricated hinges, worn rollers, loose fasteners, or a problem with the garage door tracks. Squealing, rattling, grinding, and popping sounds should not be ignored. A technician can determine whether lubrication and adjustment are enough or whether components need replacement.

A tilted or stuck door often suggests uneven spring tension, a damaged cable, worn rollers, or an blockage in the tracks. A torsion spring is installed above the door and manages its balance. An extension spring is generally positioned along the horizontal tracks. Both types are under substantial tension and can cause serious injury if handled unsafely.

Garage door rollers can become worn, crack, or come off their tracks. Replacing worn rollers may make the door quieter and reduce strain on the opener. However, forcing a crooked [Garage Door & Opener Brands](#) door or attempting to reset a spring without proper tools can damage the panels and create a risky release of stored energy.
