Each party recognizes that the other has a right to and shall fully participate in all important matters pertaining to the minor child's upbringing, including health, welfare, and education. The parties agree that they shall have shared legal custody of the minor child and that all decisions regarding the health, medical and dental care, education, religion, vacations, travel, welfare, and other aspects of the upbringing of the minor child shall be made on a joint decision-making basis.
