Pros and Cons

Pros

- Quick gameplay: each round lasts seconds, providing pleasure principle.
- Basic rules: no need for map knowledge or objective training.
- Possible for high returns (e.g., a 10 × cash-out can increase a modest stake drastically).

Cons

- **High home edge:** most sites keep ~ 2-- 5% of total wagers, making long-term earnings hard.
