2. Energy Synergy

- **Molotovs/Incendiaries:** Used to clear tight angles (like "Newell" on Inferno or "Banana") and hold-up enemy presses.
- **Smokes:** Block sniper lanes and isolate bomb sites during execution.

3. Map Control and Defaulting

Rather than hurrying a website blindly at the start of every round, competent groups develop map control (defaulting).

- Expanding across the map forces the CTs to expose their positioning.
