How Does a Case Battle Work?

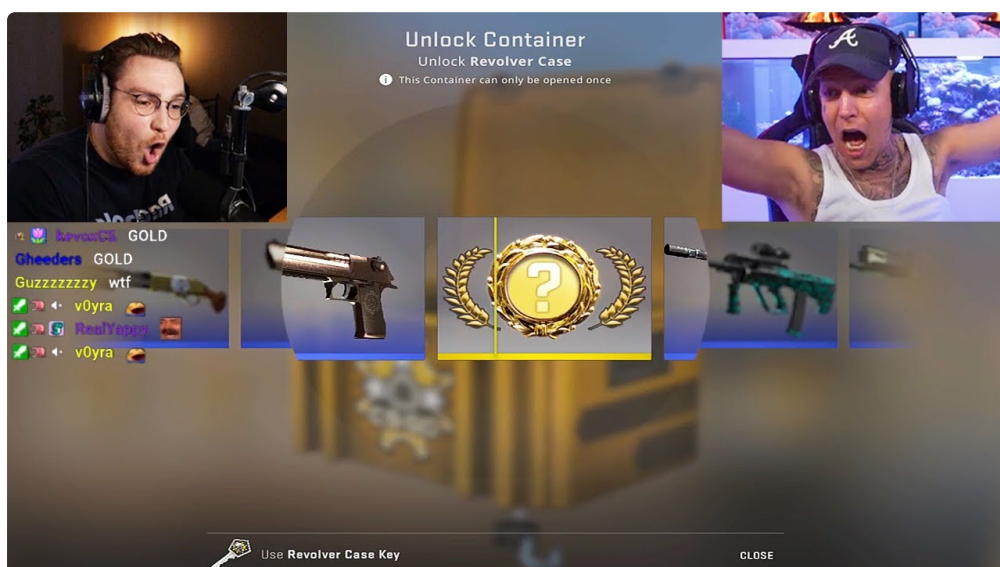
Popular Game Modes and Special Rules
