Before every main wheel spin, a leading slot above the wheel spins all at once. This top slot assigns a random multiplier to among the bet sections (either a number or a bonus game). If that sector hits on the main wheel and is matched with the multiplier, all winnings for that section are increased appropriately.

On the other hand, the reward rounds are rarer-- accounting for approximately 17% of the wheel in total-- however they offer the capacity for enormous multipliers and the video game's greatest payments.

The Four Exciting Bonus Rounds

The real appeal of Crazy Time lies in its 4 distinct bonus offer rounds. When the wheel arrive at a perk section, participating players are transported from the primary studio into an interactive, augmented-reality minigame.

1. Coin Flip

- **Frequency:** 4 sectors on the wheel.
- **How it works:** A coin with a red side and a blue side is turned by a maker. Each side is assigned a random multiplier before the flip. Whichever color lands face up identifies the gamer's payment.
- **Re-flip feature:** If the multipliers assigned to the coin are exceptionally low, the host might activate a "Rescue" re-flip to offer gamers a possibility at better values.

2. Pachinko

- **Frequency:** 2 sections on the wheel.
- **How it works:** Inspired by the conventional Japanese arcade game, players are revealed a big wall filled with physical pegs. The host drops a puck from the top, and it bounces down the board till it lands in among several multiplier zones at the bottom.
- **Double feature:** If the puck lands in a "Double" slot, all multipliers on the board double, and the host drops the puck again for even bigger rewards.

3. Cash Hunt

- **Frequency:** 2 segments on the wheel.
- **How it works:** This is a shooting gallery-style perk round. A huge screen displays 108 random multipliers hidden behind different carnival signs (such as a cactus, a target, or a chef's hat). Players use an on-screen crosshair to aim and contend one sign before a countdown timer ends. When the timer ends, all signs expose their covert multipliers.

4. Crazy Time

- **Frequency:** 1 sector on the wheel.
- **How it works:** The supreme perk round. The host opens a red door leading into a vibrant, surreal virtual world including a huge 64-segment wheel. Players should choose one of three flappers (Green, Blue, or Yellow). The wheel is spun, and whatever multiplier the picked flapper indicate is awarded. Like Pachinko, this wheel consists of "Double" and "Triple" segments, which can push multipliers up to a staggering 20,000 x.

Popular Strategies for Playing Crazy Time

- **The Safe/Conservative Strategy:**

- *Objective:* To lengthen gameplay and lessen rapid bankroll exhaustion, relying on frequent little wins.
- **The Bonus Hunter Strategy:**
 - *Focus:* Placing bets specifically on the four bonus offer rounds (Coin Flip, Pachinko, Cash Hunt, and Crazy Time).
 - *Objective:* To avoid the lower-paying base game numbers entirely and chase after the huge multipliers discovered just in the reward functions. This needs a bigger bankroll to endure droughts in between benefit hits.
- **The Balanced Approach:**
 - *Focus:* Spreading bets throughout both numbers and benefit sectors.
 - *Objective:* Keeping the balance ticking over with numbers while preserving a ticket to every major benefit round that strikes the wheel.
