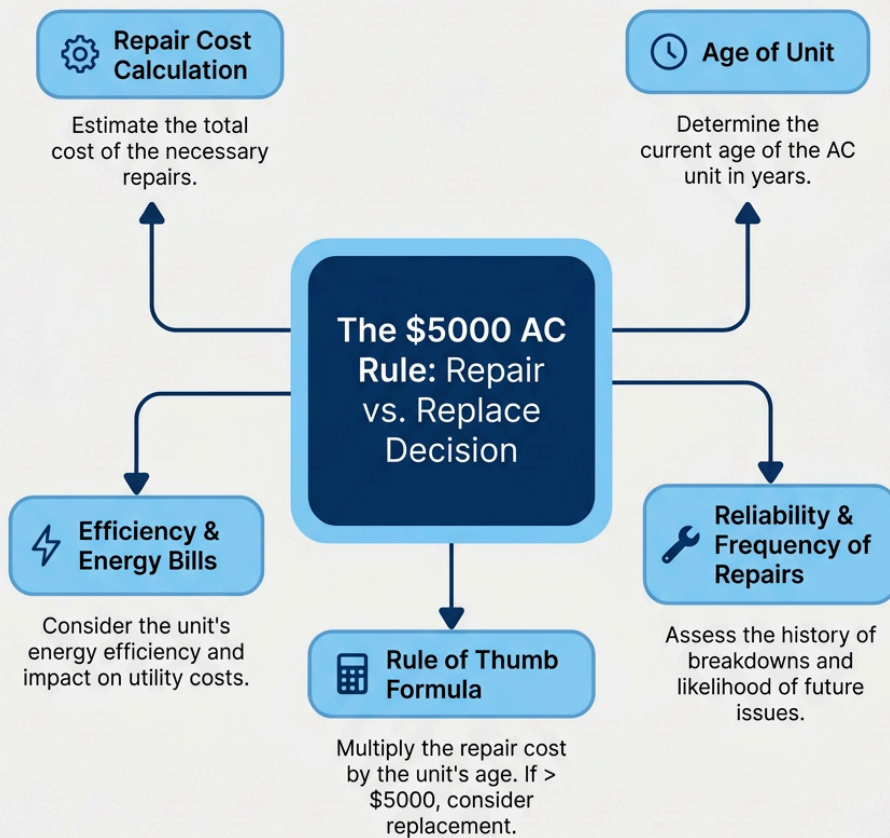

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What Leak-Check Steps Reveal About Your Unit's Replacement Timeline?

Thorough leak-check steps during routine service reveal whether your HVAC unit will reach its full lifespan or require earlier replacement. Refrigerant leaks are silent killers—a small leak today becomes a system failure in months or years if left unchecked.
