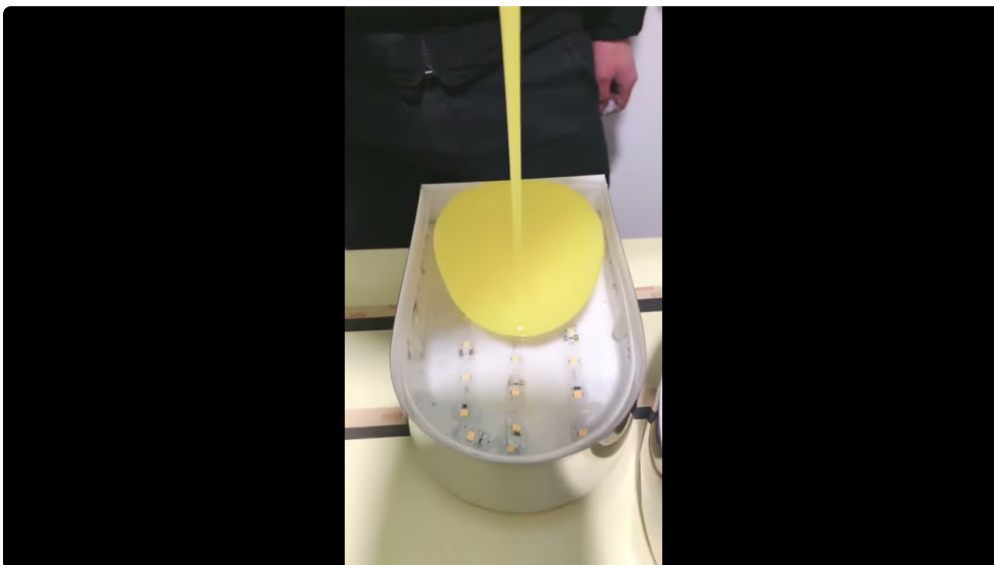

A bistro in a ancient district desired greater nighttime stroll-ins with no violating strict pointers. Raceways have been banned, shelves discouraged. We special pin-established brushed aluminum letters at 10 inches at the painted sign band, with a gentle white 3000K wall wash below a slender cover. Inside, we tightened the indoor menu to 3 panels, driven their terrific-selling mussels to the top left with a price anchor, and dimmed the menu board with the aid of 30 percentage after sundown. The facade felt brighter without gleaming. Reservations held secure, whereas bar walk-ins after 8 pm grew by means of 12 to 15 p.c. on weekends. The inspector favored it in view that each and every fastener changed into hid, and the neighbors favored it seeing that the mild became hot.
