Polished granites and marbles have top specular reflectance. Think of a glossy mag page as compared with a matte one. When pale hits polished stone, a widespread component bounces again in a unmarried path, which creates brilliant highlights. That should be awesome, but it additionally exaggerates an asymmetric substrate, a wavy cupboard run, or a crooked undercabinet gentle rail. Honed, leathers, and other textured finishes scatter mild greater diffusely. Soapstone, leathered granite, or a honed quartz received't glare as a great deal. If you utilize tunable white fixtures, resist the urge to swing colour temperature wildly. Keep a slender band. Maintenance, cleaning, and the long game

marble stayed the big name, and the lighting did what it could do: vanish as a supply and instruct off the paintings.
