How mobile locksmith help changes the job

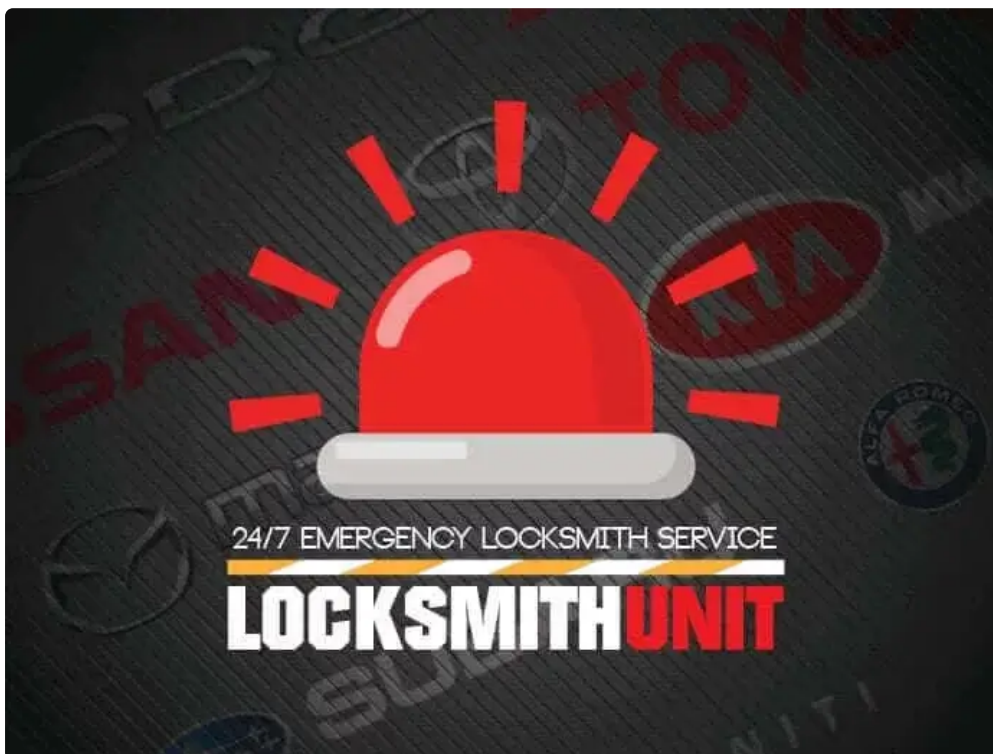
