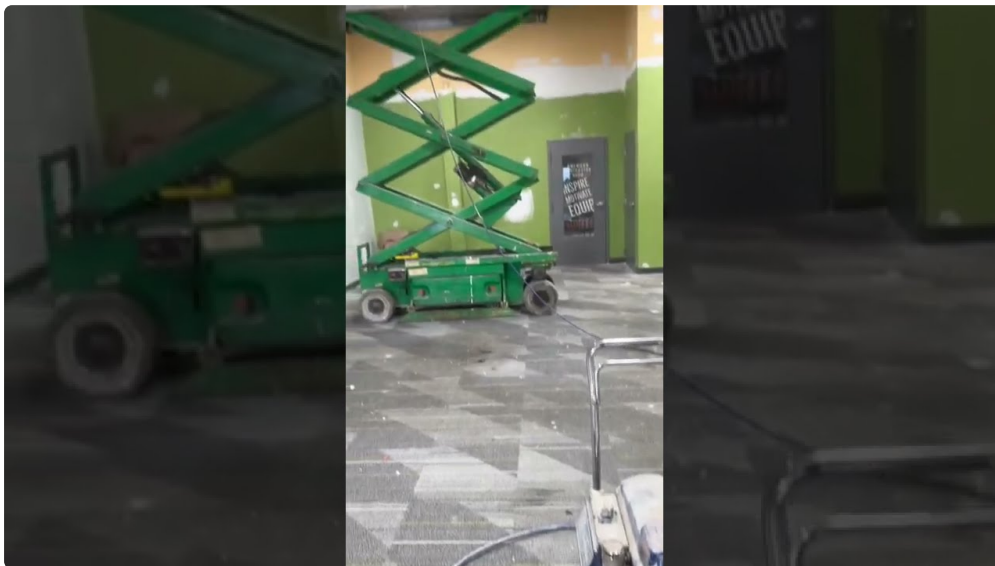

Three months later, we did a courtesy test. No blocking, no sags, and the stairwell appeared flat at sundown.
