- **Risk:** A sudden crash right at the start (e.g., 1.00 x) can still clean out revenues, but statistically, these early crashes occur less regularly than moderate ones.

2. The Split-Bet Strategy

- **Strategy:** Place 2 bets of equal size. Set the auto cash-out on the very first bet to a low-to-moderate level (e.g., 2.00 x) to protect a return of the total preliminary stake. Let the second bet run manually to chase higher multipliers (10x, 20x, or more).
- **Goal:** Cover the expense of the round early while preserving upside potential for an enormous payout.
