

Garage Door Repair Services Offered in Los Angeles

Trusted **garage door repair** helps protect your vehicle, belongings, and home while restoring safe daily access. Garage door cable repair may cost approximately \$150 to \$350, depending on whether one cable or both cables require replacement and whether the underlying drum, spring, or track is damaged. Cables that are frayed, loose, or off the drum should be addressed promptly because the door may become unstable.

Garage door track repair often requires securing hardware, realigning a track, changing damaged sections, or straightening a bent support. Usual prices may run from \$125 to \$400. A track should never be forced back into position while the door is under tension.

Record repairs and installation dates so you can spot recurring problems.
