Why does a failing HVAC system pose immediate health and comfort risks?

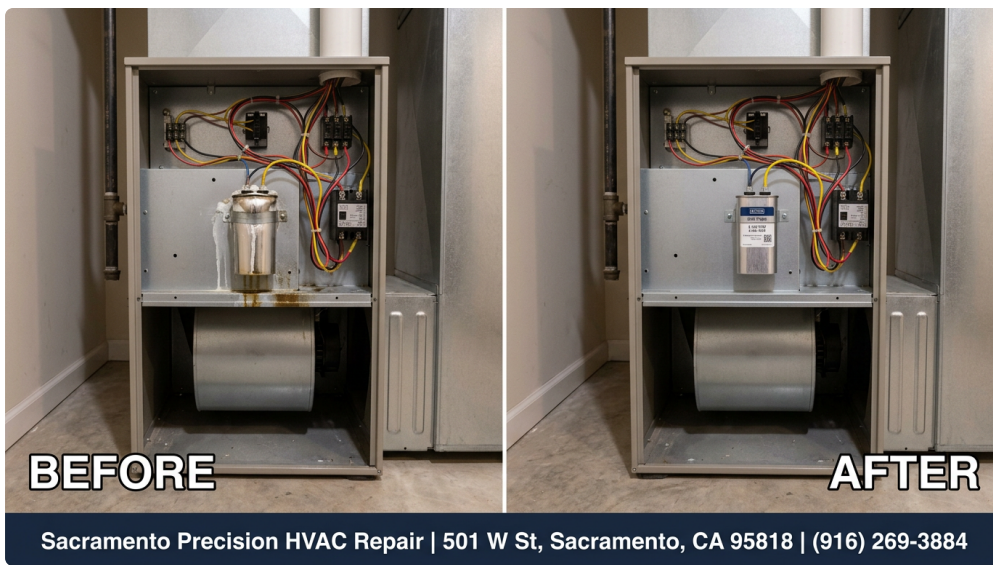

The moment you lose climate control, you're no longer managing a convenience issue—you're managing a health emergency.

How does delaying repair on an aging system escalate your total cost of ownership?

When a 25-year-old or older HVAC system begins to fail, the escalation liability is steep. A small refrigerant leak in an aging compressor might cost \$400 to repair today. If you delay that repair for two weeks, the leak worsens, the compressor burns out, and suddenly you're facing a \$2,500 compressor replacement. Wait another month, and that failed compressor damages the condenser coil, pushing your bill toward \$4,000 or more. Replace the capacitor, and the compressor fails within weeks. Fix the blower motor, and the heat exchanger cracks days later. This cascading failure pattern means each repair increases the probability of the next one, and each repair call costs money and time you can't afford to lose. The comfort-loss risk during the diagnostic visit alone—especially if we need to shut down the system to identify the problem—can exceed several hours of exposure to outside temperatures.
