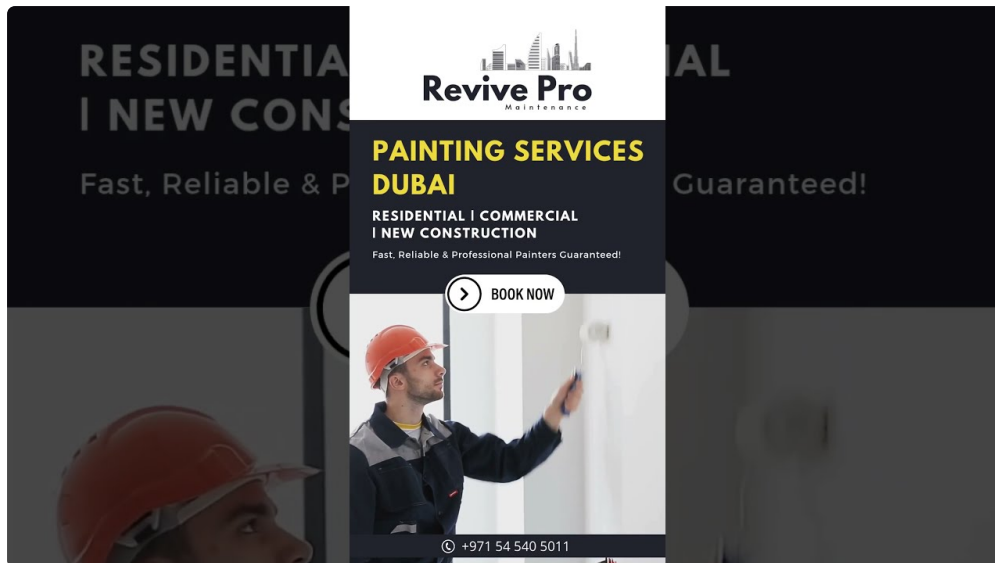

If a instant adhesion verify with a razor crosshatch and tape pull exhibits susceptible bond, we sand aggressively with 120 or 150 grit, smooth with a TSP change, and foremost with a bonding primer made for slick substrates. Over smooth builder paints, a easy mechanical scuff and a high quality acrylic primer builds a uniform base so the finish coat lays even and dries to the expected sheen.

Ceiling painting features reside or die through filth manage and coverage. Wood siding wants a graduated strategy. We wash gently with a apartment-exact purifier, not a one-measurement electricity wash. High tension etches gentle grain and invites untimely failure. Loose paint ought to move, but now not at the rate of sound timber. We scrape to a agency area, feather with eighty to a hundred and twenty grit, then spot foremost bare areas with an oil or alkyd bonding primer that blocks tannin bleed, specifically on cedar and redwood. Over sound paint, an acrylic primer-surfacer degrees minor checking and lays a uniform base. If the home has lead paint, we shift to EPA RRP lead-safe practices, meaning containment, HEPA extraction, and definite sparkling down methods.

Fiber cement and engineered timber have their quirks. Factory-primed boards fluctuate in first-rate. We test for chalk with a darkish rag. Then we build film thickness with a DTM acrylic or urethane rated for outdoors exposure. Skimping on movie build is why steel fails early.
