Color, sheen, and design decisions

We sanded profiles with foam pads and shot two topcoats of satin urethane. Doors have been sprayed flat in the store with the equal device. Hardware holes

had been crammed and re-drilled to replace from 3-inch pulls to 5-inch, which required a jig and endurance to retailer traces immediately.

From arrival to final wipe-down took eight working days. At day three after rehang, the finish felt dry but we still told comfortable use for multiple weeks. Six months later the buyer generally known as, now not with a grievance, but to agenda ceiling portray amenities in the adjacent spouse and children room considering that the cupboards made the ancient ceiling appearance worn-out. That is the ripple impact a nicely-executed cupboard finish has on a domicile.
