What is Crazy Time?

At its core, Crazy Time is a live casino game built around a giant, vertical 52-segment wheel. The video game is hosted by a live, energetic speaker who spins the wheel, communicates with the audience through live chat, and guides players through the various sectors.

What sets Crazy Time apart from standard wheel video games (like *Dream Catcher*) is the inclusion of a top slot positioned straight above the primary wheel. With every [check here](#) spin, the top slot spins concurrently, creating a random multiplier for a particular bet area. If the wheel stops on that spot and a bonus or number is multiplied, players can win astronomical payouts.

Understanding the Wheel Segments

The 52 sections on the Crazy Time wheel are divided into numbers (which pay out basic money rewards) and bonus rounds (which trigger minigames). Understanding the distribution of these segments is crucial for managing bankrolls and comprehending the video game's volatility.

The Number Bets

Players can position bets on four various numbers: **1, 2, 5, and 10**. Each number represents its payment multiplier if the wheel lands on it.

- **1:** Appears 21 times on the wheel (greatest frequency, lowest payment of 1:1).
- **2:** Appears 13 times on the wheel (payout of 2:1).
- **5:** Appears 7 times on the wheel (payment of 5:1).

- **10:** Appears 4 times on the wheel (payment of 10:1).

The Bonus Rounds

The true excitement of Crazy Time depends on its 4 reward rounds. These inhabit a combined overall of 9 sectors on the wheel, making them rarer to strike, but greatly more fulfilling.

1. **Coin Flip** (4 sectors on the wheel)
2. **Pachinko** (2 segments on the wheel)
3. **Cash Hunt** (2 sections on the wheel)
4. **Crazy Time** (1 segment on the wheel)

The Four Thrilling Bonus Rounds Explained

When the wheel stops on a bonus offer section, all players who put a bet on that particular reward round are transported to a different, immersive set (or augmented truth screen) to participate.

1. Coin Flip

The simplest of the benefit rounds, Coin Flip includes a coin with a Red side and a Blue side. Each side is assigned a random multiplier by the video game system before the flip. The host pulls a lever to flip the coin, and whichever side lands face up awards the gamer that corresponding multiplier. If multipliers are low, a "Rescue Flip" can sometimes be triggered for a 2nd chance.

2. Pachinko

Motivated by the standard Japanese arcade game, the Pachinko reward round includes an enormous wall filled with physical pegs. The video game host drops a puck from the top of the board, and it bounces randomly down through the pegs until it lands in among the multiplier zones at the bottom.

- If the puck arrive at a **"Double"** worth, all multipliers at the bottom of the wall double, and the puck is dropped again for even higher stakes.

3. Cash Hunt

Money Hunt is an interactive shooting gallery minigame. Gamers are provided with a massive screen displaying 108 random multipliers concealed behind various signs (such as a cactus, a target, or a chef's hat).

- Players use an on-screen crosshair to aim and "shoot" their chosen sign before the timer runs out.
- Once time expires, all symbols reveal their hidden multipliers, and gamers receive the multiplier connected to their chosen target.

4. Crazy Time

The crown jewel of the game is the Crazy Time benefit round. Gamers walk through a red door into a lively, virtual wonderland including a huge, 64-segment mega wheel.

- Before the wheel is spun, players should select one of three flappers: **Green, Blue, or Yellow**.
- The wheel is spun, and whichever multiplier the chosen flapper points to is awarded to the gamer.
- Simply like Pachinko, this wheel includes **"Double"** and **"Triple"** sectors. If the flapper arrive on one of these, the multipliers on the wheel boost, and the wheel is spun once again-- potentially pushing payouts

approximately the game's maximum limitation of **20,000 x**.

Secret Strategies for Playing Crazy Time

While Crazy Time is basically a game of possibility powered by a Random Number Generator (RNG) and [crazy time game](#) a physical wheel, players typically adopt specific betting strategies to handle their risk and extend their playtime.



Popular Betting Approaches

- **The Safe & Steady Strategy (Number Betting):**
 - Focus mostly on banking on numbers 1 and 2, while placing little hedge bets on perk rounds. This method yields regular, smaller sized wins and keeps the bankroll stable.
- **The Bonus Hunter Strategy:**
 - Place bets specifically on the four benefit rounds (Coin Flip, Pachinko, Cash Hunt, and Crazy Time). This is a high-volatility strategy created for players who want to experience the minigames as frequently as possible, accepting that they might experience droughts of non-bonus spins.
- **The Balanced Spread:**
 - Cover a mix of numbers and all 4 bonus offer rounds proportionally. This ensures that nearly every spin of the wheel yields some form of return or sets off a function.

Vital Tips for Beginners

- **Set a Budget:** Decide on a set bankroll before visiting and never chase losses.
- **Understand RTP:** Keep in mind that various bets have a little different Return to Player percentages. Number bets typically use a higher analytical RTP than bonus bets, but reward bets use the excitement of huge multipliers.
- **Take pleasure in the Show:** Crazy Time is created as home entertainment first. Treat the potential jackpots as a benefit to the interactive, game-show experience.
