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Walk through any Arlington area in April and you see the very same story on a lot of homes: green movie creeping up siding, dark stripes on gutters, streaks on the driveway, and brick steps that get slick after a rain. The mix of humidity, tree cover, pollen, and roadway salt in Northern Virginia is rough on outside surface areas. A great contractor can make a home look five years younger in an afternoon. A bad one can etch your brick, scar your deck, or void your roof guarantee just as fast.

Third, whether they mention cleaning the underside of gutters and soffits, which frequently hold the most visible staining.

On older brick rowhouses or painted masonry near Lyon Village or Aurora Highlands, a skilled pro will dial the pressure method down and focus on chemistry and dwell time. High pressure on old mortar can speed up collapsing and leave wand marks that end up being apparent once the wall dries.

Roof washing

Roof cleaning is where the space in between professionals and "guy with a maker" ends up being stark.

Asphalt shingle roofing systems with black streaks are very typical in Arlington. Those streaks are typically a kind of algae called *Gloeocapsa magma*. The appropriate method to resolve them is a soft wash utilizing an extremely low-pressure application of an option primarily based on salt hypochlorite (comparable to home bleach, however stronger and thoroughly mixed), plus surfactants, followed by a comprehensive rinse where appropriate.

Tile, metal, and flat roofings each require various methods.
