Benefits and drawbacks

Pros



- Quick gameplay: each round lasts seconds, delivering pleasure principle.
- Easy guidelines: no need for map knowledge or aim training.
- Possible for high returns (e.g., a 10 × cash-out can increase a modest stake significantly).
- Many platforms supply provably reasonable algorithms, allowing gamers to confirm round stability.

Cons

- **High home edge:** most sites keep ~ 2-- 5% of total wagers, making long-term profit hard.
